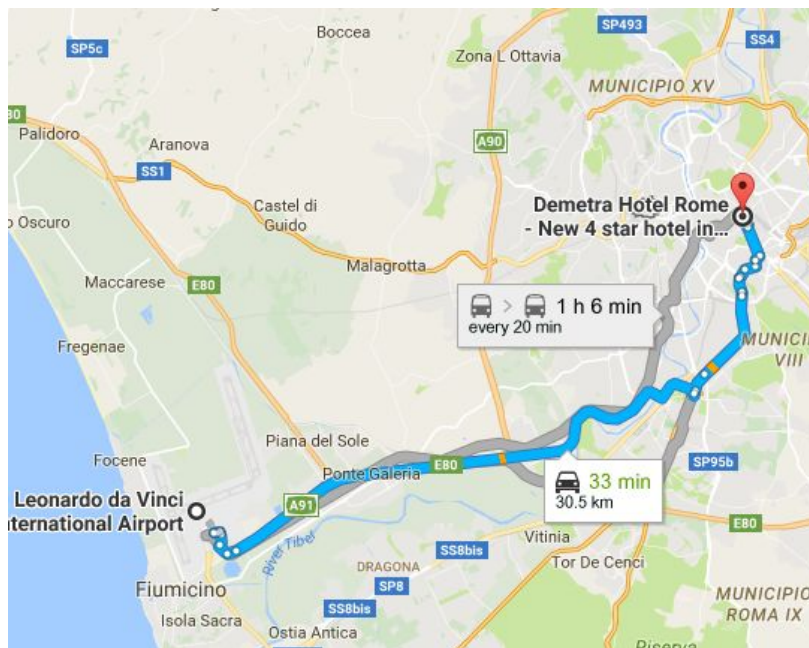

Fiumicino Airport to Rome City Centre

Fiumicino is a coastal town located outside of Italy's capital city. To transfer from the airport to Rome, you can travel by train, bus or taxi. The cheapest mode of transport is by bus and depending on traffic, it will take about 50 minutes to reach the city centre. If you choose to travel by train, you have the option of using the direct line or the local one. There are no trains or buses after midnight, so if you arrive in the airport late, you will have to hire a taxi to get into the city.

Where do I get a Taxi



You can locate the taxi stand outside terminals 1, 2, 3 and 5.

Convenience ★★★★★



Taxis in Rome

Traveling by taxi means that you can get from door to door in no time without the hassle of train transfers and waiting for buses. This is the most convenient means of transport.

Prices

The flat price of a taxi to the city centre or city ring is 48€. This includes any destination within the Aurelian walls. Any destination outside of the Aurelian walls will be taken down on the metre.

Safety ★★★★★

Taxi is always the best option when it comes to travelling from the airport to the city centre. Registered Italian taxis are white with the cities crest on the side. Alternatively, you can opt for a pre-ordered private car hire.

Availability

You can always find a taxi at the Airport, 24/7.

Tips

- The taxis in Rome can take up to 4 people with 4 luggage.
- There is a flat cost of 48 € within the Aurelian walls.
- Feel free to inform the driver that you are aware of the 48€ fixed cost inside the Aurelian Walls.
- It will take you approximately 45 minutes from Fiumicino airport to the city center depending on traffic.
- The Termini station (central railway station) is inside the Aurelian Walls.

Value for money



For all that taxis have the plus of convenience and safety, it does come with a price tag. However, the flat rate price ensures a set price – don't hesitate to inform your taxi driver that you are aware of the flat rate fare.

Editor's note

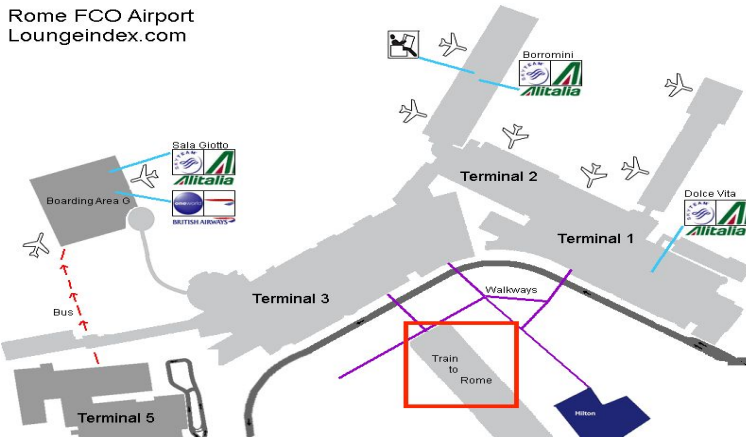
Taxis are perfect for door-to-door travel and ideal for late night transfers. However, it is not the cheapest mode of transport. On top of this, because of Rome's busy traffic, it may take longer to arrive to your destination.

Where do I get the Train

The train station is located outside Terminal 3. Signpost will direct you to the station and it takes between 10-15 minutes walking time to get from the airport to the train station.

Prices

The Leonardo Express one way ticket: 14€
The local train FL1: 8€

Availability

The Leonardo Express, which goes direct from the airport to the city centre departs every 30 minutes. It runs daily from 6:38 to 23:38.

The second option is the FL1 that stops at Trastevere, Ostiense, and Tiburtina train stations on the way to the city centre. The train departs every 15-30 minutes and starts running at 5:58 a.m until 11:38 p.m. This is a convenient option if your destination is Campo de' Fiori, Piazza Navona or the Pantheon area.

Convenience ★★★★★



The Leonardo Express from Fiumicino Airport to Rome

Because of its regular departure times, you won't be hanging around the train station for too long. The Leonardo Express takes you direct to the city centre, while the local train may take a little longer with a few stops on the way.

Safety ★★★★★

You should always take care of your belongings when traveling on public transport. If you are travelling after 10pm, it is better that you choose an alternative means of transport such as taxi or private car hire.



The local FL1 train



Tips

- The first train from Rome Airport starts at 5:58am and the last one at 23:38pm, keep in mind that there is no train after midnight
- The Leonardo Express departs from the airport every 30 minutes, during rush hours it can be more frequent
- For passengers with disability or reduced mobility Leonardo Express is equipped with dedicated seating and restrooms
- Train tickets can be bought either online or from the ticket machines before your entrance to the platforms
- Make sure that you validate your tickets at the designed validation machines, after validation the tickets are valid for 90 minutes

Value for money

If you are on a tight budget, it is best if you opt for the bus transfer as the Leonardo Express is a little pricey.

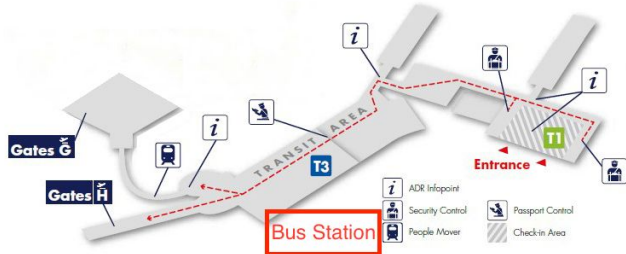
Editor's note

The train is the fastest way to travel into the city and guarantees an on-time arrival. The Leonardo Express is a better option if you are hasty to reach your destination while the local FL1 train is ideal if your destination is Campo de' Fiori, Piazza Navona or within the Pantheon area.

Where do I get the Bus



The bus departure point is located outside terminal 3 – a 10-15 minute walk from the arrivals gate.

Prices

Depending on the company you choose to travel with, prices can vary from 4€ to 8€ for a one-way ticket.

Availability

There are a number of different private bus companies to choose from that will take you to the city centre. It usually takes between 45 to 70 minutes to travel from the airport to the city centre, depending on traffic and how many stops the buses take.

A few bus companies to take note of include:

Terravision offers a non-stop ride from the airport to Rome Termini train station. This is also the cheapest option with 4€ for a one-way ticket online or 6€ at the ticket booth.

The Sit Bus goes from the airport to the Vatican, with a couple of stops on the way. A one-way ticket costs 6€ both on the internet and at the ticket booth.

The Tam Bus links the airport with Termini and Ostiense train stations. A one-way ticket is priced at 5€ while a return will cost you 8€.

Convenience ★★★★★

When transferring from airport to city centre by bus, you must always take into consideration transfer time. Traffic plays a huge role in your travel time and if you arrive at peak hour, it is important that you factor in extended transfer time.

Safety ★★★★★

When travelling solo, it is always advised to be vigilant and keep an eye on your personal belongings. If your airplane arrives after 10pm, consider taking a taxi for safer travel.



Fiumicino airport bus TAM



Tips

- Fiumicino bus stations can be found outside of Terminal 3.
- Traveling by bus is the cheapest option and the cost varies from 4 € to 6 €.
- It takes about 50 minutes to reach the city center but can take considerably longer if traffic is heavy.
- Kids under 4 years old travel for free.
- During airport rush hours you might need to wait to get to the next available bus, no matter if you booked your ticket online.

Value for money ★★★★★

At a starting price of 4€ for a one-way ticket, traveling by bus is the cheapest option when transferring from the airport to the city centre. The alternative public transport is the train, with a starting price of 8€ one-way.

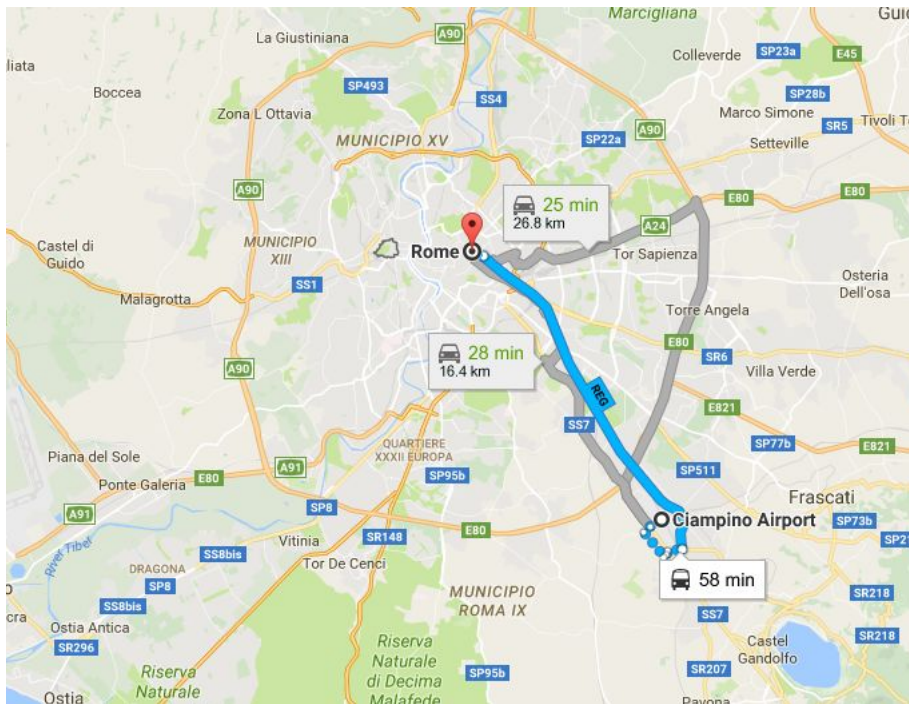
Editor's note

Traveling by bus is always the cheapest option, however, if you are hasty to arrive to the centre, it may be worth looking into train times.



Ciampino Airport to Rome City Centre

You can travel to Rome city centre from Ciampino airport using three different means of transport: the train is the cheapest option at 2.5€ one-way. You can also travel by bus, which leaves the terminal every 30 minutes, or you can hire a taxi.

Convenience ★★★★★



Taxis in Rome

Taking a taxi from Ciampino airport to Rome city centre is the most convenient mode of transport – you are able to get from A to B with minimal hassle so you have more time to relax and enjoy your holiday.

Prices

The flat price of a taxi to the city centre or city ring is 30€. This includes any destination within the Aurelian walls. If you travel to a destination outside the Aurelian walls, you will have to pay what is written on the metre.

Safety ★★★★★

By taking a cab, you allow yourself the time to relax and to think of your next trip. It gives you a considerable amount of safety in comparison to other means of transport.

Availability

You can always find a taxi at the Airport, 24/7.



Outside of Ciampino airport



Tips

- The taxis in Rome can take up to 4 people with 3 pieces of luggage.
- For more than 4 passengers or more than 3 luggage you have to book a minivan.
- The flat rate of 30 €, applies to any trip within the Aurelian walls no matter the time of day (day / night).
- Make sure to show that you are aware of the 30 € fixed cost inside the Aurelian Walls.
- It will take you approximately 30 minutes from Ciampino airport to the city center depending on traffic.
- The Termini station (central railway station) is inside the Aurelian Walls.

Value for money ★★★★★

In comparison to other taxi fares, the price of a taxi from Ciampino airport to Rome is reasonably priced. If you travel with two or more of you, then taking a taxi is good value for money.

Editor's note

The flat rate fee allows you to travel anywhere within the Aurelian walls without any added extras – this is great for door-to-door travel and allows for a smooth and easy transfer from airport to city.



Ciampino Rome Airport to the city centre by Train

Where do I find the Train



The Ciampino airport is not directly connected to the city by train. For you to travel via train, you have to take a bus from the airport to Ciampino railway station, which is located outside the arrivals. From there you can take a train to Roma Termini.

Prices

The bus journey from the airport to Ciampino railway station costs 1€ and the train to the city centre costs 1.50€ one way.

Availability

The bus departs every 30 minutes and takes 15 minutes to travel from the airport to the train station. There is a train every 20 minutes from Ciampino railway to Roma Termini. The whole trip will take about 1 hour. Unfortunately the train doesn't run after midnight.

Convenience ★☆☆☆☆



Local train

The metro is not that convenient since cars leave the station every 30 minutes. The absence of a direct line between the Airport and Piraeus, combined with the low quality service of line 1, makes it even less convenient.

Safety ★★★★★

When using public transport, it is important that you keep an eye on your personal belongings.



Bus from Ciampino airport to Ciampino railway station



Tips

- The first bus from Ciampino Airport to Ciampino railway station starts at 5:20am and runs until 23:30pm, keep in mind that there is no train after midnight
- Be aware that buses from Ciampino Airport to Ciampino railway station operates different hours on holidays. First bus at 6:40am and last bus at 23:35pm
- Buses depart every 30 minutes from Ciampino Airport to Ciampino railway station
- Trains depart every 10 minutes from Ciampino railway station to Rome Termini station
- First train depart from Ciampino railway station to Rome Termini at 05:25 am and the last one at 23:19pm
- Train tickets can be bought either online or from the ticket machines before your entrance to the platforms
- Make sure that you validate your tickets at the designed validation machines, after validation the tickets are valid for 90 minutes

Value for money ★★★★★

If you are on a tight budget, the price for both the shuttle bus and train ticket combined is very cheap. You are able to travel from the airport to the city centre without having to pay through the nose.

Editor's note

If you are on a tight budget, the train is your best option to get to the city centre. If not, consider another mode of transport as it can be quite complicated.



Ciampino Rome Airport to the city centre by Bus

Where do I find the Bus stand



There are three different bus companies that can take you from the airport to the city centre: SitBus, Terravision and Rome Airport Bus.

The SitBus station is located outside of terminal 3. The Terravision buses are found at the bus station, stop number 1 (when exiting the arrivals area, turn left and continue until you arrive at the bus station).

The Rome Airport Bus station can be found at stop number 2 (When you leave the terminal, turn left and continue until you arrive at stop number 2).

Prices

Prices vary from 4€ to 7.90€.

Availability

The Terravision buses depart every 30 minutes from 8:15 a.m. to 23:40 p.m. The SitBus starts running at 7:45 a.m. until 23:59 p.m, departing every 30 to 45 minutes. The Rome Airport Bus begin at 4:00 am until 22:50 p.m. All buses terminate at Roma Termini.

Convenience ★★★★★



SitBus

From the choice of three different bus companies, travelling from the airport to the city centre couldn't be easier. Once you land, you are sure to catch a bus.

Safety ★★★★★

We believe that riding the bus can make one feel unsafe. It is important that you keep an eye on your belongings.



Terravision bus



Tips

- There are no buses available after midnight.
- Ciampino bus stations can be found outside Terminal 3 or Polo-bus, stop number 1 or stop number 2 (out of terminal turn left , parking lot n° 2).
- Traveling by bus is the cheapest option and the cost is from 4 € to 7.90€.
- It takes about 50 minutes to reach the city center but can take considerably longer if traffic is heavy.
- Terravision offer free travel for kids under the age of 4.
- The last departure from Ciampino airport at 23:59
- During airport rush hours you might need to wait to get to the next available bus, no matter if you booked your ticket online.

Value for money

Travelling by bus from the airport to the city centre is great value for money, however, the local train is considerably cheaper.

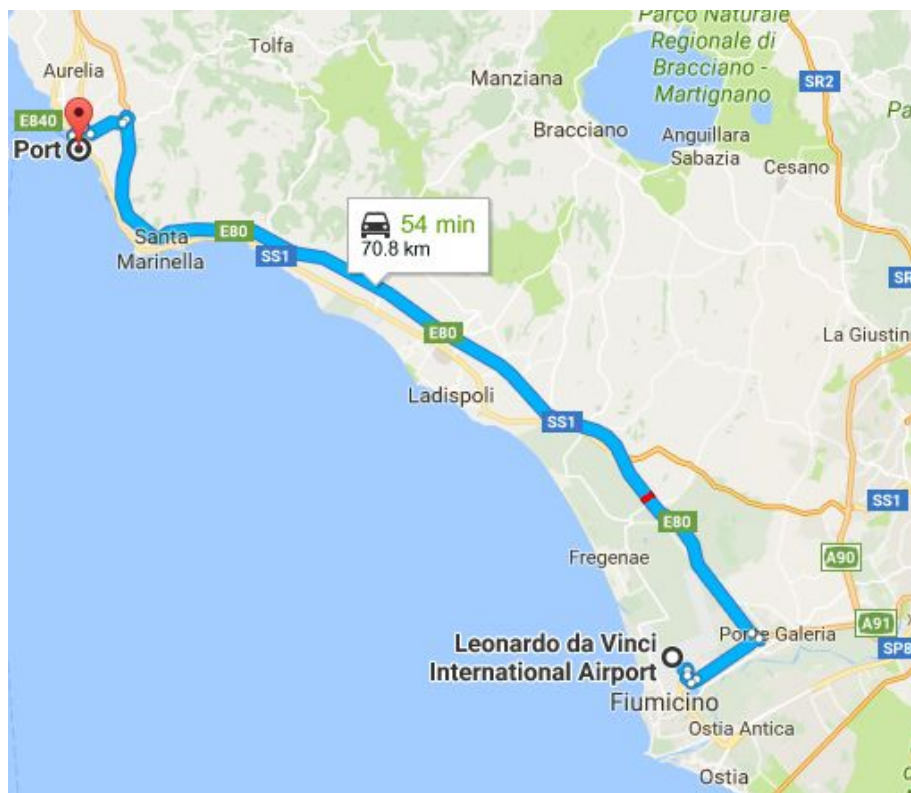
Editor's note

Travelling by bus is the cheapest and easiest option. The choice of bus companies means that there is a larger price range, and because all buses terminate at the city centre, you are sure to get to your destination safely. Buses stop running at midnight, so if you arrive late, it is advised to hire a taxi.



Fiumicino Rome Airport to Civitavecchia Port

When travelling from Fiumicino airport to the Civitavecchia port, you have two options to travel. The cheapest is by train, and involves a change in Trastevere. The other option is by hiring a private car or taxi. There is a fixed rate from airport to Civitavecchia port and it is advised to pre-book a transfer.

Where do I find the taxi rank



You will find the taxi ranks outside arrivals in terminals 1, 2, 3 and 5

Prices

There is a base price of 120€ from the airport to Civitavecchia port.

Availability

The taxi ride from Fiumicino airport to Civitavecchia port takes 50 minutes. Taxis are available at the airport's taxi ranks.

Convenience ★★★★★



Rome Taxi Cabs

Once you land at Fiumicino airport, the last thing you want to worry about is getting to the train station on time to catch the train. Taking a taxi means that you can relax and start your holiday early.

Safety ★★★★★

Opting for a taxi transfer from Fiumicino airport to Civitavecchia port is always the safest option. Registered taxi cabs are white with the Rome emblem on the side.

Tips

- The taxis in Rome can take up to 4 people with 4 luggage.
- There is a flat cost of 120 €, that remains the same no matter the time.
- Make sure that the driver restarts the meter as soon as the ride begins, feel free to show that you are aware of the flat fee to Civitavecchia port.
- It will take you approximately 50 minutes from FCO to the cruise terminal depending on traffic.

Value for money

With a base-rate price, you are sure to be paying only what is expected. Considering the travel time from Fiumicino airport to the cruise port, the base-rate price is reasonable, however, travelling by train is considerably cheaper.

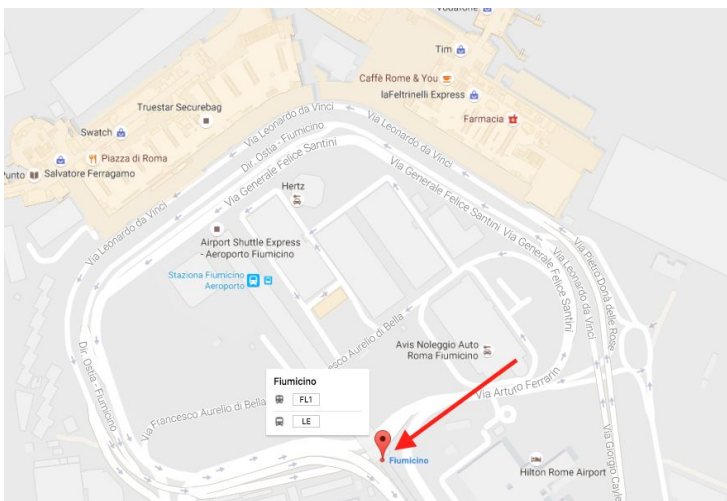
Editor's note

The railway station is situated outside terminal 3

Prices

One way ticket from Fiumicino airport: 8€

One way ticket from Roma Trastevere: 4.60€

Children under 12 years travel for free

Availability

For you to reach the Civitavecchia port from the airport you need to take the FL1 train from the airport. You should then change at Roma Trastevere station and take the FL5 train to Civitavecchia port. Unfortunately, the trains don't run after 11:38 pm.

Convenience ★☆☆☆☆



Local train to Civitavecchia port

Unfortunately, there is no direct train from the airport to Civitavecchia Port - you would have to change at the Roma Trastevere station. That's why we gave the train only one star for convenience.

Safety ★★★★★

Naturally, public transport is less safe than taking a taxi to your destination.



Civitavecchia train station



Tips

- There are no trains after 23:38 that depart from Fiumicino Railway station
- Keep in mind that you will need to change a train line that will need some walking with luggage, and very likely going up and down flights of stairs
- Train tickets can be bought either online at Trenitalia site or from the ticket machines before your entrance to the platforms
- Make sure that you validate your tickets at the designed validation machines
- From Civitavecchia train station to the piers you need to take a local "Argo" bus - ticket costs 2 €

Value for money

Taking a two-hour train to the port may seem quite a lengthy trip, however the price of a ticket makes the trip worth it.

Editor's note

The quickest and most convenient way to travel from the airport to the cruise port is by taxi. Although it is a little more costly than the train, you will arrive at the port in no time. To ensure you get to the port on time, it is advised to pre-hire a private car before arriving at the airport.
