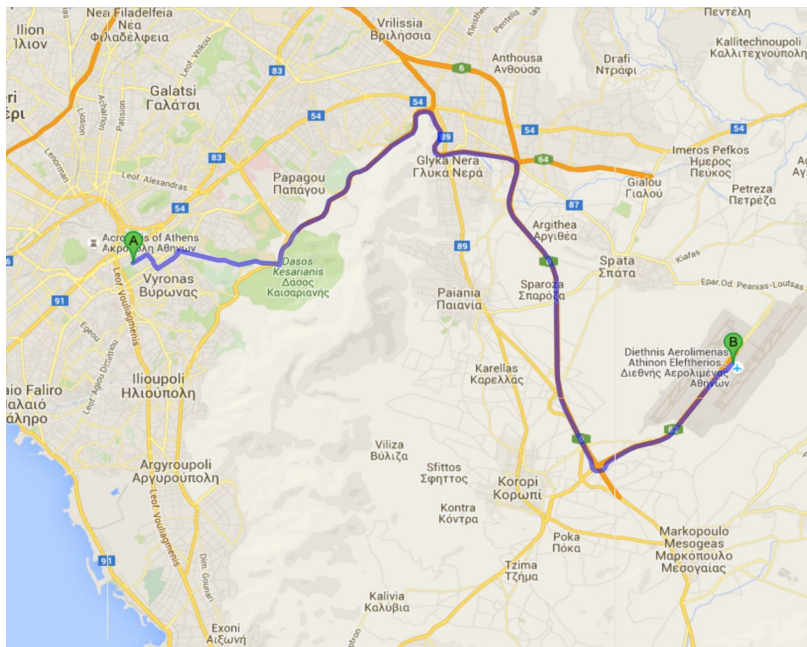

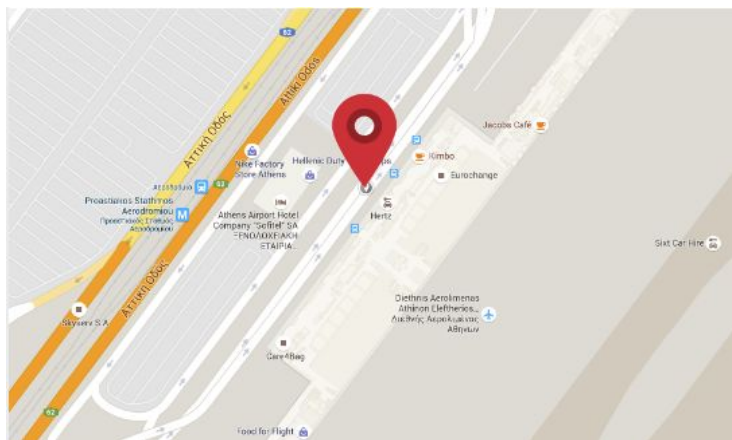

Where do I get a Taxi



You can find the designated taxi stand between the arrival Gates 2 and 3.

Prices

There is a flat fee for routes to and from the Airport.

Daytime rate (05:00 - 24:00) is 38€

Nighttime rate (01.00 - 04:59) is 54€

For routes towards or from out the City Center, there isn't a flat fee and you will be asked to pay what the meter registers.

Availability

You can always find a taxi at the Airport, 24/7.

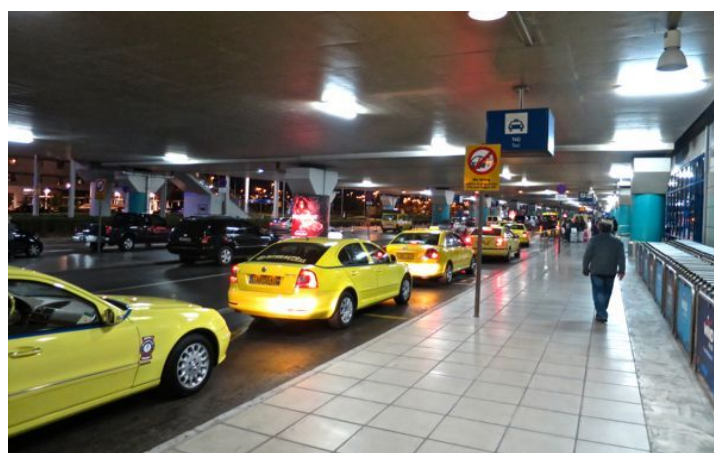


Taxis in Athens

Jumping on the back of a cab, is what everyone wants on a stressful day. You have someone drive you over, load your bags on the trunk and then, having reached your destination, hand them over to you. You just sit and enjoy the ride. This is why we rated taxis with 4 stars.

Safety ★★★★★

We believe that when taking a taxi, you allow yourself a sense of safety, you are not cornered in a metro, you allow yourself to take your time and you are not anxious with asking for directions. Thus we believe taxis are rather high on the safety level.

Tips

- Feel free to ask of the fare beforehand, while also let your driver know that you are aware of the flat fee for the city center.
- The majority of taxis do not accept credit cards.
- Local legislation states that no more than 4 passengers and 4 luggage are allowed in one car.

Value for money

Having landed, tired and most likely jet-lagged. You can't be bothered, you just want to open the door of your hotel room, take off your shoes and take a shower or lie down for a while.

That's why a cab worths its money; no questions asked, just state your destination and off you go.

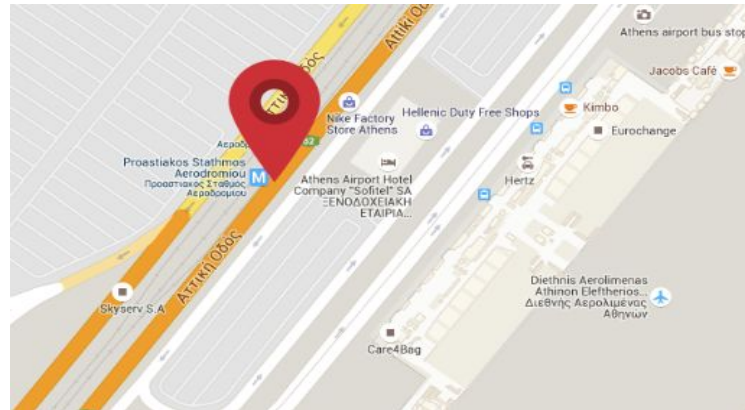
Editor's note

Yes, taxis are relatively reliable and way more comfortable than the metro and buses. Where do I get the Metro



The entrance to the station is outside the airport. Follow the signs and you will find yourself in the terminal with the glass ceiling. It takes approximately 40 minutes to reach the city center.

Prices

One way ticket: 10€
Round trip ticket: 18€
Two (one way ticket): 18€

Children under 6 years old can use the metro for free.

Availability

Unfortunately the metro does not operate 24/7. The first tube leaves the Airport station at 06:30 and the last one at 23:30.

While the first one from Syntagma leaves the station at 07:08 and the last one at 00:08.

Metro in Athens

The tube's frequency is quite slow: a tube leaves the station every half an hour. It also gets quite busy during rush hours. You might have to stand while you hold your luggage. However, it covers a considerable distance as the Airport is located at the city's outskirts.

Safety ★★☆☆☆

The metro does give you a sense of safety. It's modern, and rather spacious. The hearing announcements will save you the trouble of looking for your station. However, expect to be crammed during rush hours, which can be stressful.

So, does it worth it?

The metro is modern and relatively convenient; but it's network is not that dense, it does not expand throughout the city center. There are a number of districts you can only access by foot or car.

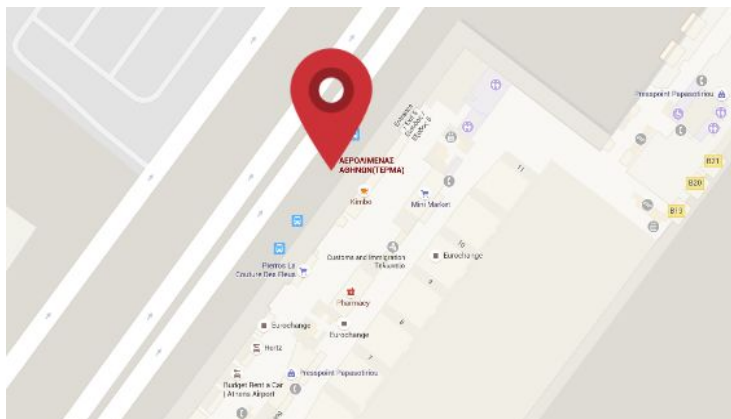
Editor's note

You can find the bus stand, between the exits 4 and 5. It takes approximately 60 minutes to reach the city center of Athens.

Prices

Adult - One way ticket: 6€
Children 7-18 and Seniors: 3€

Buses are a cheap way to go around a city but the amount of time and the effort needed. Makes us question its value.

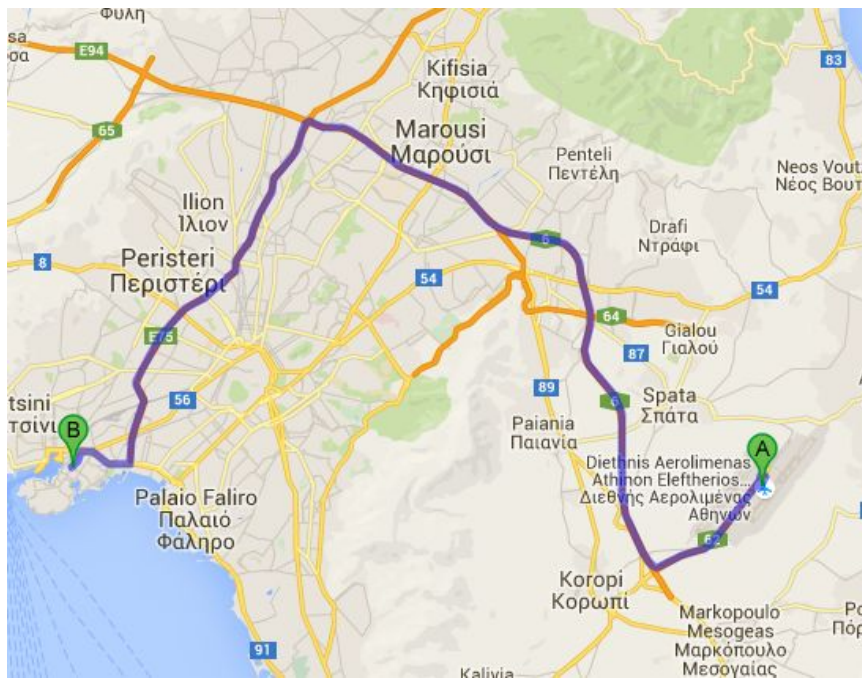

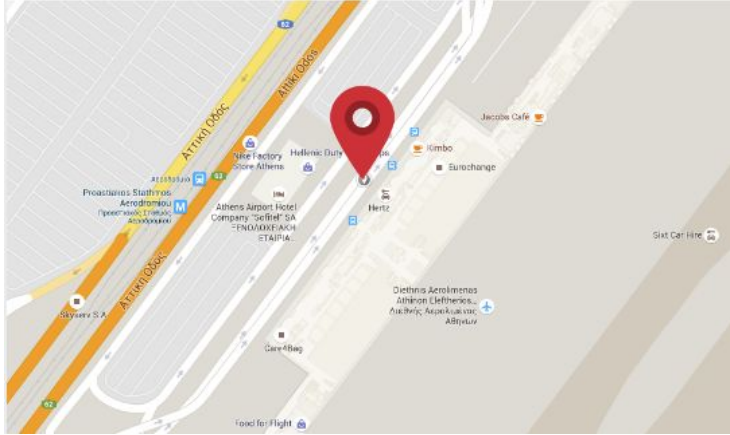

Where do I get a Taxi



You can find the designated taxi stand between the arrival Gates 2 and 3.

Prices

There isn't a **flat fee** for routes from and to the Airport. You will be asked to pay what the meter registers.

An estimate would be

Daytime (05.00 to 00.00): 49€
Nighttime (00.00 to 05.00): 65€

You can always find a taxi at the Airport, 24/7.

Taxis in Athens

Taking a cab is really convenient, considering the long distance of the Piraeus port from the Airport, around 50 km. The former is located on the Southeast end of the city while the latter on its South-west outskirts. There is no direct access from one to another: one has to go either through the city center or reach the city's South suburbs and head North.

This is why riding a taxi is quite convenient.

Safety ★★★★★

By taking a cab, you allow yourself the time to relax and to think of your next trip. It gives you a considerable amount of safety in comparison to other means of transport.

Value for money ★★★★★

Tips

- Try asking beforehand for a fare estimate
- The majority of drivers do not accept credit cards
- Local legislation indicates that no more than 4 passengers and 4 luggage can be loaded in one car
- Try asking for your route before hand, either through the city center or another one, and ask for the estimated duration of your ride

The ride to the City's biggest port is long. Sitting at the back of a car, your big luggage in the trunk, and getting ready to board a ferry after a long flight. Seems to us a good value for your money.

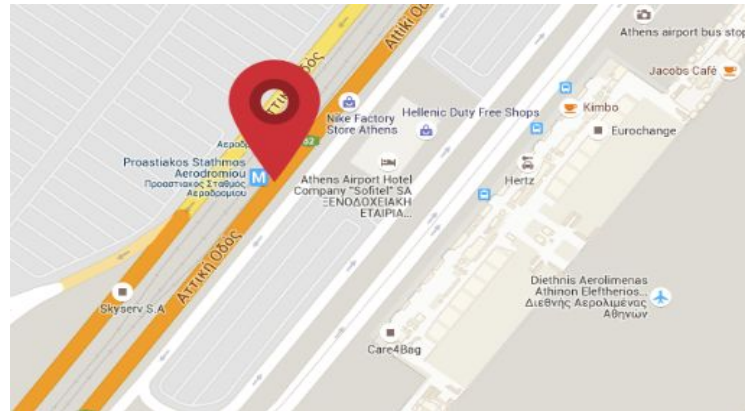
Editor's note

Where do I find the Metro



The entrance to the station is outside the airport. Follow the signs and you will find yourself in the terminal with the glass ceiling. It takes approximately 40 minutes to reach the city center and then you will need 15 minutes from city center to Piraeus port.

Prices

One way ticket: 10€
Round trip ticket: 18€
Two (one way ticket): 18€

Children under 6 years old can use the metro for free.

Availability

Unfortunately the metro does not operate 24/7. The first tube leaves the Airport station at 06:30 and the last one at 23:30. There is a tube every 30 minutes.

Convenience ★☆☆☆☆

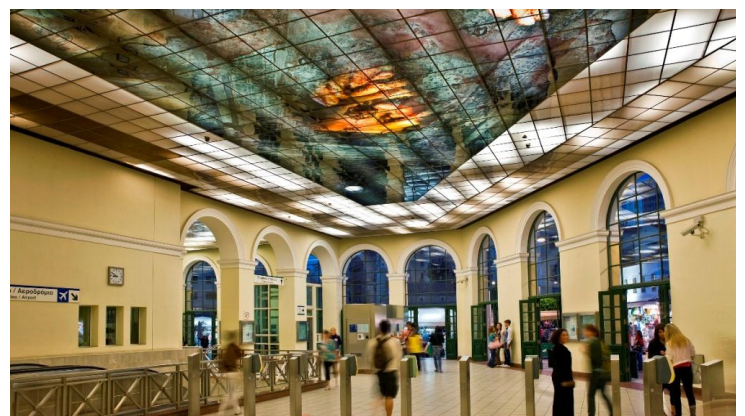


Metro Station in Piraeus port (green line)

The metro is not that convenient since cars leave the station every 30 minutes. The absence of a direct line between the Airport and Piraeus, combined with the low quality service of line 1, makes it even less convenient.

Safety ★★☆☆☆

The blue line does give you a sense of safety. It's modern, and rather spacious. The hearing announcements will save you the trouble of constantly looking where to stop. However, the line 1 is really slow and not that safe.

- Be sure to check whether the stamp is readable, some stamping machines malfunction
- Most of the cars leaving the airport have luggage trays, look for them
- You can issue tickets at every metro station
- Each ticket is valid for 90 minutes

- You can pay both with bank notes and coins for your ticket
- Metro station at Athens airport is totally accessible and there are also elevators
- Be aware that you will have to change metro line in Monastiraki station and head to Piraeus port with metro line 1 (green line)

Value for money ★☆☆☆☆

Considering the time and effort required, having to use two lines, blue and line 1, makes the use of metro tiresome. Also should you be a group taking the metro shouldn't be your first choice. As with the taxi fare should be only a few more euro.

We so believe that the metro has low value for your money.

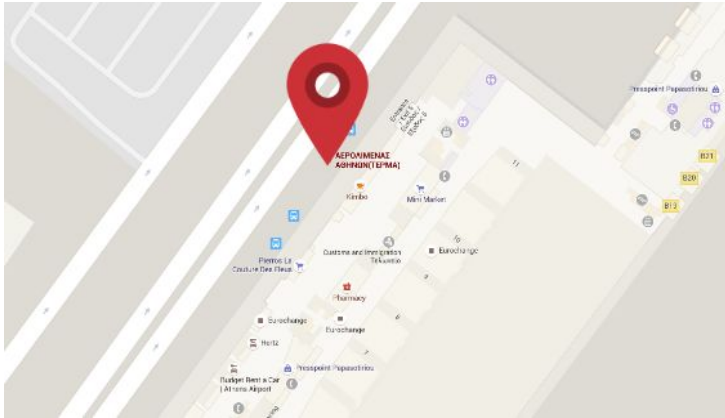
Editor's note

Taking the metro will give you a sense of security, you know where to change. The lack of a direct metro line makes things worse. It would be best to allow yourself a considerable time when booking your ferry tickets.

Where do I find the Bus stand



You can find the bus stand between exits 4 and 5. The line (X96), takes approximately 70 minutes to reach Piraeus.

Prices

Adult - One way ticket: 5€
Children 7-18 and Seniors: 2.5€

The X96 line runs 24/7.

We believe that riding the bus can make on feel unsafe. There are no road signs indicating you are headed to the port and no landmarks showing you are in Athens.

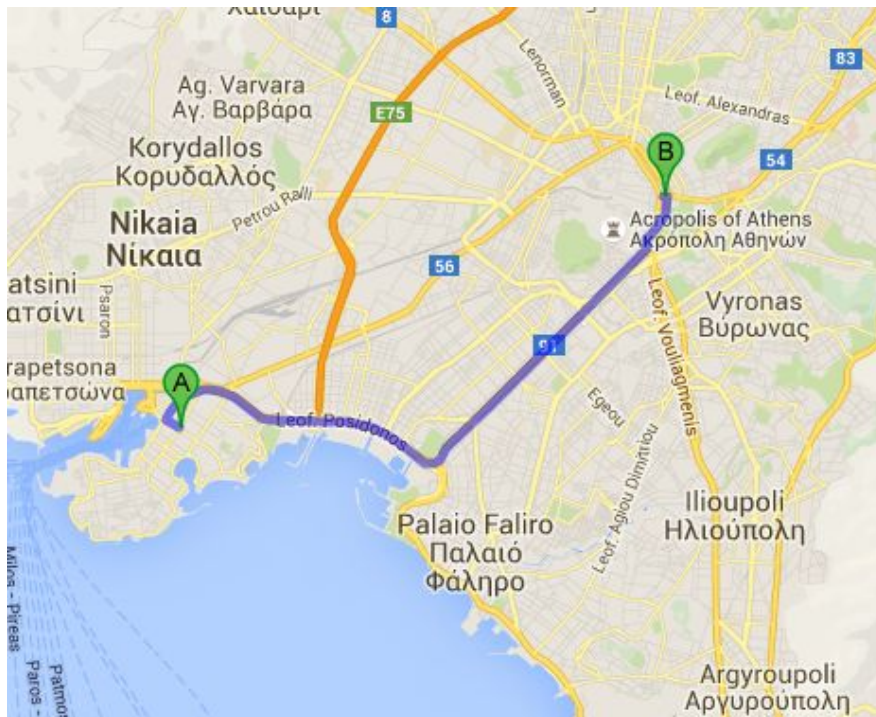
Editor's note

Where do I find a Taxi Stand



Piraeus port

There is a designated taxi stand in every docking station within each gate. Beware the port authorities allow for taxis only when a cruise ship or ferry is docking. The shortest way to reach the city center is through the Syngrou Boulevard.

Prices

There aren't any flat fees from Piraeus to the city center. You will be charged what the meter registers.

An estimate is 25€ during daytime and at nighttime the ride is 38€.

Availability

The taxi stand at the Piraeus port is running 24/7.

Convenience ★★★★★



Taxi rank at Piraeus port

You just want a smooth transition to everyday life. You are back from your holidays. You are not really eager to look for a bus or change metro lines. You just want to go back to your hotel, no questions asked. Well a short taxi ride would be nice.

Safety ★★★★★

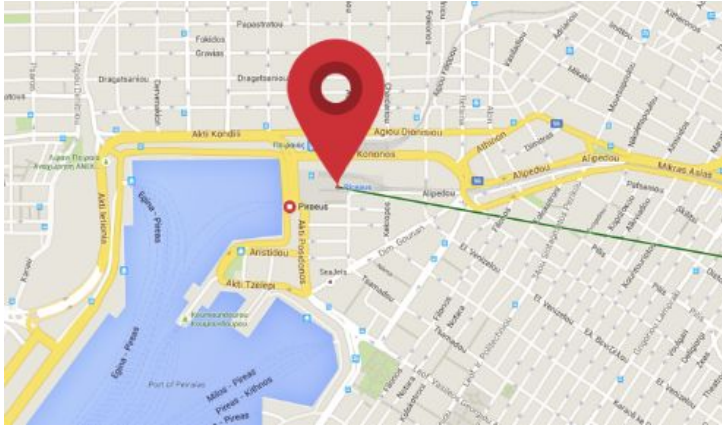
Editor's note

Metro Station in Piraeus port (green line)

The metro line 1, or green line, is a suburban one and has some service issues. Hence its relatively low speed. Should you need to change lines, you won't find it that easy changing lines.

Safety ★★☆☆☆

The green line is inconvenient and so one can easily feel unsafe. There have been a few occasions where the railway had had to stop its service abruptly. It does not make a newcomer eager to explore Athens.

Where do I find the Bus stand



The bus stand is located further away from the port gates and the Metro terminal, on the end of boulevard Akti Miaouli.

The Express line X80 terminates to Syntagma square while also stopping at the Segrou Metro station.

Prices

You can use this line only with the following tickets:

24 hours: 4.5€

Tourists' ticket: 22€ (3 days duration and return ticket to the airport)

Availability

The first bus departs at 07:30 and the last one at 21:30. There's a bus every 30 minutes.

Convenience ★★☆☆☆



This Express line is exclusively for tourists, however. Having its stand to the end of the port and its infrequent service makes it highly inconvenient.

Safety ★★☆☆☆

The fuzz about X80 is to get yourself to the bus stand. You are in for some struggle, not that appealing when returning from a long trip. Considering the above we believe the bus service has a low safety ranking.

Value for money

Riding the X80 line is a great value for your money should you have some time to spend. The tickets are not that cheap but the line makes only one stop. So a relatively good value for your money.
